

BAT SPECIFICATIONS

(Effective 2017 Fall Season)

9U + 10U DIVISIONS

- Barrel size may be either 2 ¼" or 2 5/8" in diameter
- Maximum length is 33 inches
- Composite barrel permitted with 1.15 BPF stamped on the bat with any drop permitted

11U DIVISION

- Barrel size may be either 2 ¼" or 2 5/8" in diameter
- Maximum length is 33 inches
- Composite barrel permitted with 1.15 BPF stamped on the bat with any drop permitted.

12U DIVISION

- Solid one piece wood bat (ash or maple)
- Maximum length is 33 inches
- Barrel size permitted is 2 ½" in diameter
- **NOT PERMITTED: Composite wood, bamboo, graphite, metal**

13U/80 DIVISION

- Barrel size may be either 2 ¼" or 2 5/8" in diameter
- Maximum length is 34 inches
- Composite barrel permitted with 1.15 BPF stamped on the bat with any drop permitted.
- BBCOR stamped bat (-3 drop) is permitted for use

13-15 DIVISION

- Only composite barrel bats certified and marked BBCOR .50 are permitted
- Maximum barrel diameter is 2 5/8"
- Maximum length is 34 inches
- Solid one piece bat (ash or maple material) is permitted

SCHOLASTIC DIVISION (JAYVEE + VARSITY)

- Only composite barrel bats certified and marked BBCOR .50 are permitted
- Maximum barrel diameter is 2 5/8"
- Maximum length is 34 inches
- Solid one piece bat (ash or maple material) is permitted

NOT PERMITTED AT ANY LEVEL IS 2 ¾" BARREL DIAMETER BAT

BPF = Bat Performance Factor

NOTE: Effective January 1, 2018 all bats in the 9U, 10U, 11U, 12U, 13U Divisions must comply with new USA Baseball bat standard---Bat must be stamped USABat. The 1.15 BPF will no longer permitted for use.
